

## International Admissions Information

Welcome International Students!

Located for over 55 years in Orange County and 25 years in the city of Yorba Linda, Heritage Oak Private Education (HOPE), accredited by National Independent Private Schools Association, is a nationally recognized Blue Ribbon School.

At Heritage Oak, preschool, pre-kindergarten, kindergarten and elementary grades enjoy a calm, encouraging learning environment with a core curriculum that is one year ahead of the public school standards. All students utilize their own personal iPads in class to enhance their studies and to prepare them for challenges in high school and college. All Heritage Oak students receive a well-rounded education that includes music, French, Spanish, art, physical education, computer skills and etiquette.

#### **Program**

Heritage Oak offers a well-rounded program that includes extras that are not offered at many other schools. The fine arts are emphasized with specialty teachers for art, instrumental and vocal music, French, Spanish, computers, physical education, and etiquette. Students in grades four through eight participate in after school sports leagues and a wide range of after school extra-curricular programs. Most Heritage Oak graduates go on to study at the honors level at private or public high schools.

### **English Requirement for Admission**

International students who apply to be admitted at HOPE must complete the ITEP or TOEFL exam as well as Heritage Oak's Placement Exam

**ITEP** SLATE: *International Test of English Proficiency Secondary Level Assessment Test of English* - The student must pass the ITEP test with a minimum score of 4.5. The test can be administered and scored by an overseas partner and results an be sent to Heritage Oak with the application to the school.

**TOEFL**: Secondary Level English Proficiency Test - The student must pass the TOEFL Junior Standard test with the score of 845 or higher. This reflects a CEFR level of B2.

If the student has taken another English Proficiency Test, we will accept a score equivalent to a CEFR level of B2. The test can be administered and scored by an overseas partner and results can be sent with the application to the school.

Students must also complete the Heritage Oak Placement test in their home country and again upon arrival at HOPE to rule out any discrepancies.

#### **Admissions Procedures**

The application process is virtually the same for International and United States students. However, International Students are strongly encouraged to apply as soon as possible to ensure that visas and other documentation are completed and received in time.

Applications will be considered by the Admissions Committee when all of the required application documents have been received. Applicants will be required to participate in a Zoom interview. Applicants are notified promptly of the Committee's decision. Once the enrollment contract, and \$2,500 non-refundable New Student & Registration fees are received, the Director of Admissions can release the I-20 signed forms for the student to apply for the F-1 visa.

#### Step 1: Complete the International Student Application Form, as well as the Heritage Oak Application Form

A non-refundable application fee of \$125.00 (US Dollars) and a non-refundable evaluation fee of \$75 must accompany the application.

• Intarnational Student Application Form - This form needs to be completed by the student with a complete profile and attached picture. Attach an extra page if more space is required.

#### **Step 2: Request Recommendations**

<u>Teacher Recommendation Form</u> - Please have the English teacher complete the form and attach an assessment of English comprehension.

\*These confidential forms should be sent directly to Heritage Oak.

#### Step 3: Assemble and mail the admissions package

Send the completed application forms along with the following:

- A copy of the applicant's grades from the last two school years and current grades translated into the U.S. grading system
- A photograph of the applicant
- A copy of the current passport including page(s) indicating name, date of birth, and other vital information
- A bank statement, translated into American currency
- Official SLATE or TOEFL Test results
- \$200 non-refundable application/evaluation fee, remitted by money order or official bank check.

#### **International Student Tuition Fees - 2024/205**

Tuition fees cover costs for academic instruction and participation in the basic school programs, textbooks, field trips, and a student yearbook.

These fees do not include private music lessons, tutoring, sports team fees, performing arts fees, uniforms, or lunch.

Fees vary according to grade level. Fee payments are indicated on the attached tuition sheet and fees are due by option chosen.

#### **Refunds & Withdrawals**

Once the enrollment contract and registration fee are received, student withdrawals must be made in writing, and must reach Heritage Oak before May 1, 2024. If a parent or guardian withdraws after this date, the contract yearly tuition must be fulfilled, unless the student has been denied the F-1 visa for a legitimate reason. If the visa is denied then the applicant must present an official letter or document from the US Embassy or Consulate stating the reason(s).

### **Living Accommodations**

At this time, Heritage Oak does not provide housing to International Students.

#### **Important Information**

All students must possess a passport, valid for the duration of the academic year and six months afterwards, when entering the United States. All international students are required to have a student visa to enter the United States and attend HOPE. Please make an appointment with the US Embassy or Consulate in the country you reside in and present your passport and I-20 and complete the visa application form. It will take 8-10 weeks to process the student visa, so please plan ahead. You will not be able to stay at HOPE or the United States on any other VISA except an F-1 student visa.

Students are accepted for the entire academic year.

Your Preschool or Pre-kindergarten child's presence at school must be acknowledged by their teacher before you depart. You must sign your Preschool or Pre-kindergarten child in and out each day.

Children will not be released to anyone other than the parents unless the school has been notified in advance in writing. In the event of an unexpected need to send another person to get your child, a phone call will suffice. Proper identification will be required of the person picking up the student.

Textbooks are the property of the school and must be returned in good condition or your account will be charged.

Heritage Oak is a uniform school. All students in grades Junior Kindergarten-Eight are expected to follow the uniform dress code.

Children with colds or other illnesses will not be allowed in the school. We require that a child be kept home for 24 hours after a fever has broken, to avoid relapse. The school should be notified of any allergies.

Fees for all extra-curricular classes, sports, and tutoring must be paid before the classes or sessions begin.

Information included in school promotional materials may change as our programs grow and develop and as our staff changes. Prior to relying on any written materials in making your decision to enroll or re-enroll, please verify the accuracy of information with the Admissions Director or Executive Director.
