

Dear Early Learner, Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten Parents,

Thank you for choosing Heritage Oak! Enclosed is a packet of forms, which you will need to complete before your child attends Early Learners, preschool or pre-kindergarten at Heritage Oak Private Education.

The forms included are:

- 1. Parents' Rights
- 2. Physician's Report & a copy of the Immunization Record
- 3. Child's Pre-admission Health History—Parent's Report
- 4. Personal Rights
- 5. Parent Consent for Administration of Medication and Medication Chart
- 6. Department of Social Services Requirements

Each of these forms must be completed and returned to the school office **before June 1st or prior to your child's start date.** If any forms are missing, please call the front office immediately and we will forward them to you.

In addition, you will need to bring in current immunizations prior to the beginning of school:

Polio - 3 doses DTaP - 4 doses Hep B - 3 doses Varicella - 1 dose

MMR 1 dose on or after 1st birthday Hib 1 dose on or after 1st birthday

\*One Hib dose must be given on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday regardless of previous doses. Required only for children younger than 5 years old.

DTaP = diphtheria toxoid, tetanus toxoid, and acellular pertussis vaccine

Hib = Haemophilus influenzae, type B vaccine

Hep B = hepatitis B vaccine

MMR = measles, mumps, and rubella vaccine

Varicella = chickenpox vaccine

We are unable to allow your child to begin school until all of these forms are on file with our administrative office due to licensing regulations. ## CHILD CARE CENTER NOTIFICATION OF PARENTS' RIGHTS

#### PARENTS' RIGHTS

As a Parent/Authorized Representative, you have the right to:

- 1. Enter and inspect the child care center without advance notice whenever children are in care.
- 2. File a complaint against the licensee with the licensing office and review the licensee's public file kept by the licensing office.
- 3. Review, at the child care center, reports of licensing visits and substantiated complaints against the licensee made during the last three years.
- 4. Complain to the licensing office and inspect the child care center without discrimination or retaliation against you or your child.
- 5. Request in writing that a parent not be allowed to visit your child or take your child from the child care center, provided you have shown a certified copy of a court order.
- 6. Receive from the licensee the name, address and telephone number of the local licensing office.

- 7. Be informed by the licensee, upon request, of the name and type of association to the child care center for any adult who has been granted a criminal record exemption, and that the name of the person may also be obtained by contacting the local licensing office.
- 8. Receive, from the licensee, the Caregiver Background Check Process form.
- NOTE: CALIFORNIA STATE LAW PROVIDES THAT THE LICENSEE MAY DENY ACCESS TO THE CHILD CARE CENTER TO A PARENT/AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IF THE BEHAVIOR OF THE PARENT/AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE POSES A RISK TO CHILDREN IN CARE.

#### PERSONAL RIGHTS

#### **Child Care Centers**

Personal Rights, See Section 101223 for waiver conditions applicable to Child Care Centers.

- (a) Child Care Centers. Each child receiving services from a Child Care Center shall have rights which include, but are not limited to, the following:
  - (1) To be accorded dignity in his/her personal relationships with staff and other persons.
  - (2) To be accorded safe, healthful and comfortable accommodations, furnishings and equipment to meet his/her needs.
  - (3) To be free from corporal or unusual punishment, infliction of pain, humiliation, intimidation, ridicule, coercion, threat, mental abuse, or other actions of a punitive nature, including but not limited to: interference with daily living functions, including eating, sleeping, or toileting; or withholding of shelter, clothing, medication or aids to physical functioning.
  - (4) To be informed, and to have his/her authorized representative, if any, informed by the licensee of the provisions of law regarding complaints including, but not limited to, the address and telephone number of the complaint receiving unit of the licensing agency and of information regarding confidentiality.
  - (5) To be free to attend religious services or activities of his/her choice and to have visits from the spiritual advisor of his/her choice. Attendance at religious services, either in or outside the facility, shall be on a completely voluntary basis. In Child Care Centers, decisions concerning attendance at religious services or visits from spiritual advisors shall be made by the parent(s), or guardian(s) of the child.
  - (6) Not to be locked in any room, building, or facility premises by day or night.
  - (7) Not to be placed in any restraining device, except a supportive restraint approved in advance by the licensing agency.

### **Department of Social Services Requirements**

Dear Early Learner, Preschool, and Prekindergarten Parents,

- It is a requirement of the Department of Social Services that each child in our Preschool Program be provide a morning and afternoon snack. Each of these snacks must be from two different food groups. Although we will not require your child to eat when he or she is not hungry, please pack these foods from home so they are available.
- The Department of Social Services has the authority to enter and inspect a facility without advance notice. The Department has the authority to interview any children or staff in order to undergo inspection, as well as audit Child Care Center records, without notice.
- The Child's authorized representative shall complete a current individual written admission agreement for the child. This document must specify the basic services, payment provisions, modifications conditions, refund conditions, rights of the Department, and termination provisions. The school will provide a 30-day written notice if any changes occur to the written agreement.
- The Department of Social Services require all parents to sign their child in and out daily using their FULL LEGAL SIGNATURE. If cited for not following this requirement, a fine of \$150.00 will be issued to the school. This fine will be charged to the parent's account if assessed.
